POSITION OVERVIEW

HNP is seeking a full-time Principal to join our team. In this role you will be responsible for managing clients who are leaders in the US and global climate advocacy, policy and strategy space. In addition, you will be overseeing a significant new multi-year project supporting climate policy implementation, working with leadership and external partners, as well as the larger HNP team. An ideal candidate will have experience in climate policy work managing significant projects, coordinating teams, have strong written and verbal communication skills, be highly collaborative and mission-driven, have a can-do attitude for problem-solving, and thrive in a fast-paced, remote work environment.

We will consider applications on a full-time salaried basis. This job is remote with the ability to work in multiple US time zones.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Lead on 4-6 clients at a time
 - Client management, including regular communications over Zoom

- Client work, including report writing, strategy, project management in close coordination with junior staff
- Client project operations, such as tracking hours, budget and deliverables
- Support business development through network outreach, proposal drafting, and client cultivation
- Build capacity for our firm (project management, business development tracking, strategic/future growth planning, etc.)
- Management and mentoring of junior staff
- Public facing exposure, e.g. speaking, writing, etc. to elevate HNP profile, build client base
